

Test file for the Euro symbol : €

It is very easy to get the euro symbol (€) as soon as one is able to input it at the keyboard and display it on the screen :

- Set the encoding of your file to latin9 : this will convert any occurrence of the character 164 to the command `\texteuro`

If you prefer to use the package `eurosym` available on CTAN (as I am now used to), add in the latex preamble :

- `\usepackage{eurosym}`
- `\providecommand{\texteuro}{\euro}`

and that's all : €€€€€€€€€€€€€€€€€€€€€€

The package `eurosym` (not mandatory, of course) gives you other possibilities, as expressing amounts according to your country uses, but I didn't investigate these ways.
